



- ▶ Fresenius Medical Care is the world's largest provider of products and services for individuals with renal diseases. As of September 30, 2020 Fresenius Medical Care was treating 349,167 patients in 4,073 dialysis clinics. Along with its core business, the company provides related medical services in the field of Care Coordination.
- Fresenius Kabi offers intravenously administered generic drugs, clinical nutrition and infusion therapies for seriously and chronically ill patients. The company is also a leading supplier of medical devices and transfusion technology products. In the biosimilars business, Fresenius Kabi develops products with a focus on oncology and autoimmune diseases.
- Fresenius Helios is Europe's leading private hospital operator. Helios Germany operates 86 hospitals, ~125 outpatient centers and 6 prevention centers. Quirónsalud operates 46 hospitals, 70 outpatient centers and around 300 occupational risk prevention centers. In addition, the company is active in Latin America with 7 hospitals.
- Fresenius Vamed manages projects and provides services for hospitals and other health care facilities worldwide and is a leading post-acute care provider in Central Europe. The portfolio ranges along the entire value chain: from project development, planning, and turnkey construction, via maintenance and technical management to total operational management.





RELATIVE SHARE PRICE PERFORMANCE FRESENIUS SHARE VS. DAX




